

PRCE committee meeting April 27

The meeting started with roll call and quorum was established

SVCE Dream Home Exhibit Planning

Steve Schmidt and Anand were present to discuss SVCE dream house exhibit. The meeting focused on planning to bring SVCE's Dream Home exhibit to the upcoming picnic. Anand explained that SVCE had previously discussed bringing the exhibit to the picnic and agreed to bring it this year, though the organization had forgotten about the commitment until recently. Steve shared a video about the Dream Home exhibit, which showcases electrified home appliances and features a Ford F-150 powered by clean energy. The exhibit is designed to help community members understand the size and functionality of electric appliances, with a

focus on promoting home electrification as a solution to climate change.

Dream Home Exhibit Placement Planning

The meeting focused on planning the placement of a dream home exhibit at an upcoming event. Steve explained that the exhibit would help educate attendees about electric water heaters and furnaces, aligning with the town's climate action plan. Jasmeen and Steve discussed potential locations. They confirmed that the exhibit could be set up the day before the event and would require security, with options including temporary cameras and trailer-mounted security measures. The group clarified that they could not block handicapped parking spaces or through traffic areas.

Pathways Run

The meeting focused on planning for the upcoming event. For the Pathways Run on May 9th, Noah confirmed he had volunteer

roles assigned and would need staff assistance with registration starting at 8am, with t-shirt distribution scheduled for the previous Friday.

Picnic Event Planning Meeting

The meeting focused on planning for an upcoming picnic event. The team discussed finalizing the picnic mailer, with Yibin and April working on design adjustments including aligning food lines parallel to committee tables to improve flow and interaction. The conversation ended with a request to remind committee members about the picnic date and table arrangements. There was discussion regarding committee involvement, including setting up a table and volunteering for various tasks like registration and ice cream service. The group confirmed details about the classic car show, including mailers being sent out and awards being prepared. They also addressed communication improvements. The conversation ended with

a reminder that pets are not permitted at the event.

Community Center Table Tennis Proposal

Jasmeen discussed the possibility of introducing table tennis at the community center, exploring locations near City Hall and considering a pop-up table option to gauge interest. They discussed logistics, including the need for proper groundwork, potential equipment theft, and the possibility of using a private table initially. The group also explored the idea further by potentially setting up a table at an upcoming picnic to assess interest and discuss it in future committee meetings. However given difficulty in organizing this plan was to hold off on this idea for now.

Pickleball Courts Development Planning

Jasmeen discussed plans to develop pickleball courts in the town. She proposed forming an ad hoc committee to advance the project, with potential funding coming from

private donors rather than town resources. Council member Stanley Mok was supportive of the idea and expressed confidence in raising funds through donor contributions, particularly from pickleball enthusiasts, and mentioned having a list of interested community members who could help with the initiative.

Heritage House Planning Discussion

Discussion focused on potential use of heritage house for community meet up. April suggested to contact Carol Gottlieb, who was identified as a key point person with extensive local history knowledge, and has information regarding the Heritage House.

PRCE Meeting Reschedule and Planning

Jasmeen announced that the May PRCE meeting on May 25th would be skipped due to Memorial Day holiday and the next meeting was rescheduled for June 1st.
